<p>God </p>	<p>God is our Father in heaven who made everything and loves us.</p>
<p>Noah </p>	<p>Noah was a good man who listened to God and built a big boat called an ark.</p>
<p>covenant </p>	<p>A covenant is a special promise between God and His people.</p>
<p>sin </p>	<p>Sin is when we make wrong choices and do not follow God's way.</p>
<p>psalm </p>	<p>A psalm is a song or prayer to God, found in the Bible.</p>
<p>sacraments </p>	<p>Sacraments are celebrations where we meet God in a very special way.</p>
<p>baptism </p>	<p>Baptism is when someone is welcomed into God's family with holy water.</p>
<p>Father </p>	<p>A father is someone who cares for us - God is our Father in heaven.</p>
<p>Bible </p>	<p>The Bible is God's special book that teaches us about His love.</p>
<p>Old/New Testament </p>	<p>The Old Testament is the first part of the Bible about God's people before Jesus. The New Testament is the second part, about Jesus and His followers.</p>

Hear - what scripture will we hear?



- The story of Noah, focusing on God's covenant (promise) with Noah and all living beings in the sign of the rainbow (Gen 9:7-17).(145)
- LS 71 'Through Noah, who remained innocent and just, God decided to open a path of salvation. In this way he gave humanity the chance of a new beginning. All it takes is one good person to restore hope!'
- Psalm 139(146) in praise of God's Creation of each of us and his love for us.

Believe - what do Christians believe?



- God makes a covenant (promise) with Noah to save all living things.
- That people in the story of Noah turned away from God and chose to act badly; this is behaviour called sin.
- The Sacrament of Baptism is when a person becomes part of the Christian family and promises to love God.
- That the Christian Bible is split into two parts, the Old Testament, and the New Testament.

Celebrate - how we act as Christians



- Psalms are prayers to praise God.
- Sacraments are living signs of Jesus' love for all people.
- Baptism is the first sacrament which welcomes people into the Christian family.

Live - Catholic Social Teaching



- Ways in which we can show care for God's world (stewardship) as part of our care for each other.
- How a baby is baptised in the Catholic Church.
