<p>Miracle</p> 	<p>A powerful act of God that shows His love, such as healing or calming a storm.</p>		
<p>Parable</p> 	<p>A story Jesus told to help people understand God's message, often using everyday examples.</p>		
<p>Magi</p> 	<p>Wise men who followed a star to find and give gifts to baby Jesus.</p>	<p><u>Celebrate – how we act as Christians</u></p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Praying the 'Our Father' helps Christians to continue to build the kingdom begun with Jesus.</li> </ul>	<p><u>Live – Catholic Social Teaching</u></p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• About the life of a saint who worked to build the kingdom of God.</li> </ul>
<p>Adoration</p> 	<p>A special prayer of love and worship for God.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>What should I already know?</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• John the Baptist is a prophet who calls people back to God by encouraging them to say sorry. Baptism is a sign of forgiveness.</li> <li>• That when people make bad choices (sin), they turn away from God. Jesus teaches that God loves and forgives and that being sorry helps us to change and become better people.</li> <li>• Jesus' miracles are signs that show he is the promised one (Messiah).</li> <li>• Jesus' parables are simple comparisons that invite people to know more about God.</li> <li>• Jesus brings healing in different ways.</li> </ul>	
<p>Adoration of the Magi</p> 	<p>When the three wise men visited baby Jesus and gave Him gifts, showing He is the King and Son of God.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>In Year 4, I will learn:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jesus is the Messiah/Christ but in a way that subverted the expectations of those of his own day: Jesus comes as a suffering servant, not a triumphant king.</li> <li>• Jesus is fully God and fully human. We call this belief the incarnation.</li> <li>• Jesus reveals the kind of messiah he is by showing that God's Kingdom includes those who are excluded by society.</li> <li>• Jesus showed compassionate healing in mind and body through his ministry and continues to do so through His Body, the Church, especially in the sacraments, such as the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Anointing of the Sick.</li> </ul>	
<p>Epiphany</p> 	<p>The feast when we remember the visit of the Magi and how Jesus was revealed to the world as God's Son.</p>
