Baptism is a sign of forgiveness. • That when people make bad choices (sin), they turn away from God. Jesus teaches that God loves and forgives and that being sorry helps us to change and become better people. • Jesus' miracles are signs that show he is the promised one (Messiah). • Jesus' parables are simple comparisons that invite people to know more about God. • Jesus brings healing in different ways.
John the Baptist 	The prophet who prepared people for Jesus and baptised Him in the River Jordan.		
Temptation 	When we feel pulled to do something we know is wrong.

Forgiveness 	When we are sorry and God shows us mercy and love by forgiving our sins.
