<p>Mission</p> 	<p>The work God gives us to share His love and message with others.</p>	<p><u>Celebrate - how we act as Christians</u></p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Feast of the Presentation of Jesus is celebrated by Christians around the world and is known as Candlemas in Britain. 	<p><u>Live - Catholic Social Teaching</u></p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All Christians are called to follow Jesus and share the Good News with others. • Christians are called to take care of each other, especially those most in need, such as the poor.
<p>Son of God</p> 	<p>A title showing that Jesus is truly God's Son.</p>		
<p>Light</p> 	<p>A symbol for Jesus, who brings truth, goodness, and guidance to the world.</p>	<p style="color: green;"><u>What should I already know?</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jesus was born for everyone. • The Magi visited Jesus with gifts. • Jesus is God's Son and came for everyone. • Jesus' birth is celebrated at Christmas. • Jesus came to show God's love and welcomes everyone. • Jesus takes care of everyone. 	
<p>Candlemas</p> 	<p>A feast on 2nd February remembering when Jesus was presented in the Temple. Candles are blessed to remind us Jesus is the light of the world.</p>	<p style="color: green;"><u>In Year 2, I will learn:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • John the Baptist is a prophet who calls people back to God by encouraging them to say sorry. Baptism is a sign of forgiveness. • That when people make bad choices (sin), they turn away from God. Jesus teaches that God loves and forgives and that being sorry helps us to change and become better people. • Jesus' miracles are signs that show he is the promised one (Messiah). • Jesus' parables are simple comparisons that invite people to know more about God. • Jesus brings healing in different ways.
