<p>Ascension </p>	<p>When Jesus returned to Heaven, 40 days after the Resurrection.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Celebrate - how we act as Christians</u> </p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • That the Church celebrates the Ascension and Pentecost on special days of celebration (holydays of obligation). • The words of the 'Glory Be' prayer. • An age-appropriate hymn referencing the Holy Spirit. 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Live - Catholic Social Teaching</u> </p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How Pentecost is celebrated in another part of the world. • How artists and musicians around the world celebrate the work of the Holy Spirit and the mystery of the Trinity.
<p>Pentecost </p>	<p>The day the Holy Spirit came to the apostles, helping them spread the Good News.</p>		
<p>Church </p>	<p>The people of God who follow Jesus, not just a building.</p>		
<p>Glory Be </p>	<p>A short prayer that praises the Holy Trinity: God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>What should I already know?</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Holy Spirit is our friend. The Holy Spirit looks after us • Coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. • The Good News of Jesus lived out by the early Christian community. 	
<p>Gospel </p>	<p>The 'Good News' about Jesus found in the first four books of the New Testament.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>In Year 2, I will learn:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • God is love. Love is God's first gift poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit. • The fruits of the Spirit are the visible signs that a person is led by the Holy Spirit. • The fruits of the Spirit are love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.
